Maths:

This year we have introduced the scheme, Maths No Problem, we will be sending more information out to parents during this half term.

Languages:

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Reading:

Your child will have a reading book to support daily reading. Your child is expected to read at least four times a week and books can be changed at school on a Wednesday. Reading diaries will be checked at school so please make sure the home learning packet is brought in daily and the reading diary is dated and signed.



Spelling:

Spellings will be handed out every Monday and these will be tested on a Friday. Children are expected to put their spelling books on the pile every Friday morning for new spellings to be put in. It is their responsibility to make sure they have their new weeks spellings.



P.E:

Children must come into school in their P.E kits every Thursday ready for P.E with Mr Ashby in the afternoon. Swimming kits must be in school on Fridays ready for swimming.

Water bottle:

Every child has a named water bottle which is kept in school. These are filled and cleaned in school.

Break and Lunchtime Information:

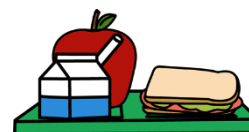
At lunchtime Mrs McCann is the Year 3 DRA.
