Mrs Hinton is the Year 4 teacher.

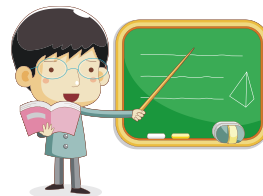
Mrs Entwistle is our teaching assistant that helps us every morning. On a Monday and Wednesday afternoon, Mrs Timms also joins us for additional support.

Reading:

Your child will have a reading book to support daily reading. This can be changed every Thursday. Your child is expected to read at least four times a week; please sign and date your child's reading diary to indicate that they have read. This will be checked at school so please make sure the reading packet is brought in daily.

Spelling:

Spellings will be handed out at the beginning of each half term. They will be stapled in their books and listed week by week. Spellings will be tested on a Friday.



PE:

Children must come into school in their PE kits every Thursday ready for PE with Mr Ashby in the afternoon.

Water bottle:

Every child has a named water bottle which is kept near them. They have the responsibility of re-filling this when needed. The bottles are cleaned in school.

Break and Lunchtime Information:

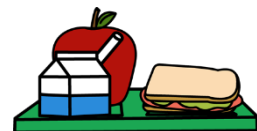
At lunchtime Mrs Boyce is the Year 4 DRA.
