Mrs Mole is the Year 5 teacher.

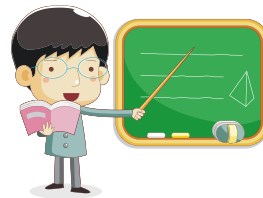
Mrs Bailey is our teaching assistant on Mondays and Tuesdays and also Friday mornings. Miss Thompson is the Year 5 one to one support.

Reading:

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Spelling:

Spellings will be handed out at the beginning of each half term. They will be stapled in their books and listed week by week. Spellings will be tested on a Friday.



PE:

Children must come into school in their PE kits every Friday ready for PE with Mr Ashby in the afternoon.

Water bottle:

Every child has a named water bottle which is kept on their desk. They have the responsibility of re-filling this when needed. The bottles are cleaned in school.

Break and Lunchtime Information:

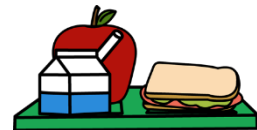
At lunchtime Miss Thompson is the Year 5 DRA.
