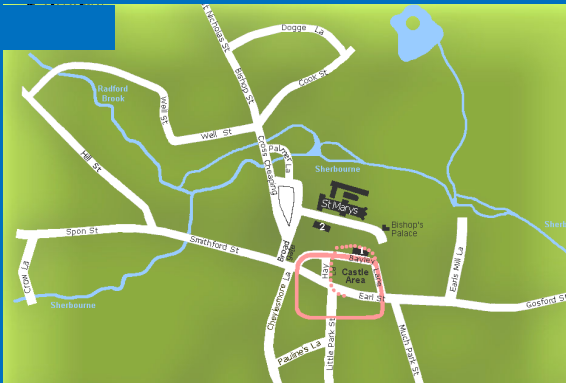




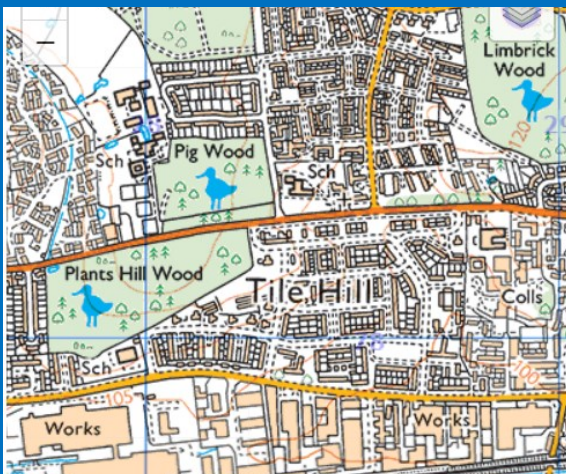

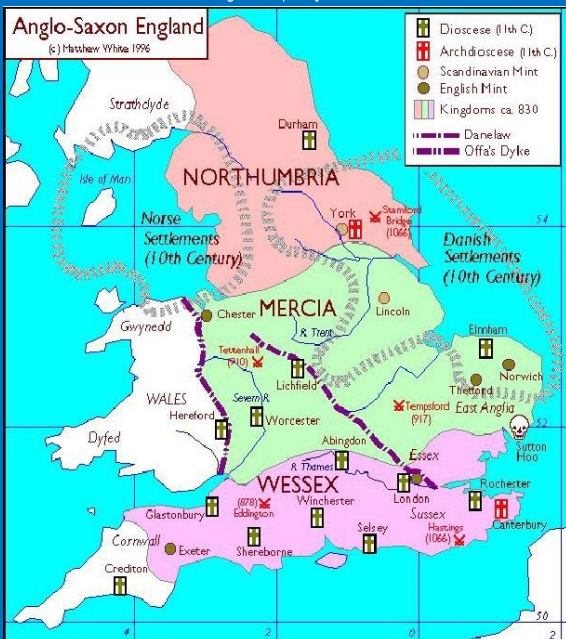

Key Vocabulary

settlement	A place where people live
rural	an area located outside of towns and cities, sometimes called the countryside: people often live far apart in rural areas
suburban	an area on the edges of towns and cities where people live: suburban areas often have green space and homes often have gardens
urban	an area where a large number of people live near to each other: urban areas have lots of buildings and roads
conurbation	an urban area that has developed when the sub-urban areas of several towns or cities merged
population	the number of people living in an area
sparse population	few people living in an area, homes are spread out
dense population	Many people living in an area, homes are close to one another
